## Did you know?

- ★ Nova Scotia has the highest concentration of universities per capita. It also has the highest rate of university graduates per capita in Canada.
- ★ Every year, more than 600 athletes (students) participate in the Jeux de l'Acadie.
- ★ The Université de Sainte-Anne is the only francophone university in Nova Scotia and offers both college and university courses.
- ★ The Titanic sank off the coast of Nova Scotia in 1912.
- ★ The oldest and largest Black community in Canada is located in Nova Scotia.
- ★ The Halifax Citadel National Historic Site is the most visited national historic site in Canada.
- ★ Windsor, Nova Scotia is considered the birthplace of ice hockey.
- ★ The U.S. border is about a 3-hour drive from Nova Scotia.
- ★ The Mi'kmaq are the largest Indigenous group in Nova Scotia. Their presence goes back to about 10,000 years.
