Our pathways program is unique in Canada, and 30% of our graduating students stay in our province to pursue post-secondary studies. Nova Scotia recognizes the value of our students and provides incentives for NSISP students to remain in the province after graduating from high school.



# POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS IN NOVA SCOTIA OFFER NSISP GRADUATES

- 1. Guaranteed university admission with an average of 70% on required courses.\*
- 2. Guaranteed waiver of the English proficiency exam for university applicants with 70% or higher in Nova Scotia grade 12 academic English (or equivalent).
- 3. Guaranteed scholarship to students with an average of 85% or higher.\*
